
This pertains to the reported kidnapping of three Community Social Workers by heavily armed men in Brgy Kapanikian, La Paz, Tarlac last May 19, 2009 as reported by PSSUPT RUDY LACADIN, Provincial Director of Tarlac Provincial Police Office to PACER yesterday, May 25, 2009 where one of three abducted victims, one Melissa Roxas, was released in Manila yesterday.

In this connection, may we respectfully invite Ms Melissa Roxas to our Office at her soonest available time to shed light on the incident? We were informed by Sister Cecille Ruiz that KARAPATAN is the proper channel to contact Ms Roxas. We have contacted your Office yesterday and today but no reply has so far been received by our Office regarding this matter.

PACER is the Anti-KFR body of the PNP. Thus, we would like to extend our utmost assistance to her for the possible identification of the perpetrators and the eventual filing of cases against all malefactors in assistance to FNP PRO 3.
